Construction of a vocational school for administrative occupations in Vienna's 5th municipal district.

**Project data**

The 6-storey school building has a GFA of 5,820 m<sup>2</sup> and comprises classrooms with a usable area of about 95 m<sup>2</sup> each as well as training offices for 600 students.

**Project description**

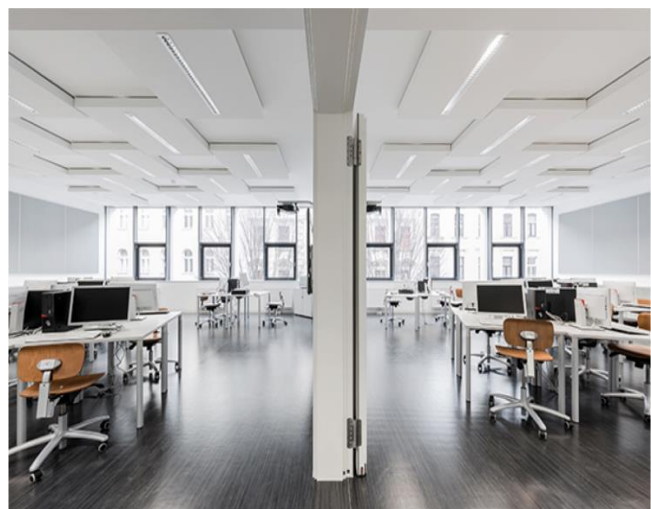
The ground floor area together with the buffet and the clearly structured schoolyard is the communicative core of the school building. A generous 2-storey foyer provides access to the classrooms on the upper floors. In addition to the classrooms there are also training offices, a gymnasium and a multi-purpose room for about 120 persons. The architectural design was carried out by AllesWirdGut Architektur ZT GmbH.

**Project specifics**

The inner-city location and the high building density there made the underpinning of adjacent buildings necessary.
