**Project objectives**

Redevelopment of the Viennese tourist attraction Cobenzl in 1190 Vienna

**Project description**

The City of Vienna intends to redevelop the Viennese leisure destination Cobenzl. Based on the “Weitsicht Cobenzl” concept an architectural competition was launched, from which the architecture offices most likely architecture and Realarchitektur emerged as winners.

**Project data**

New buildings with a floor space of approx. 2,000 m<sup>2</sup> are to be built in the area, including a café and two halls for events. The existing buildings with a total floor space of 1,800 m<sup>2</sup> will be refurbished, including the castle and the Meierei. In addition, open spaces, terraces and accessible roofs totalling 3,000 m<sup>2</sup> will be renovated or newly created.

**Project specifics**

A special focus lies on the revitalisation of the “Kuppelsaal”. Build around 1900 in secessionist style, the “Kuppelsaal” with its just 8 cm thick concrete shells will be the centrepiece of the ensemble.
